Growing Roses Organically/Partnering with Mother Nature Pam Greenewald, Owner Angel Gardens, Alachua Organically Grown Heirloom and Modern Roses

Angel Gardens is one of only four commercial rose growers in the world growing roses organically. This means they are not addicted to drugs and thrive like nature intended. Grown on their own root stock with no chemical fertilizers or insecticides, these roses are hardier and require less care than grafted roses.

Owner and grower, Pam Greenewald loves reading, writing, and talking about roses. In addition to her nursery, Pam started a non-profit, Rose Garden Angels, Inc., which uses horticulture therapy to help veterans suffering from PTSD and other disorders.
