### Bygone Treasures Along the Amelia River Gerbing Gardens, The Legacy of One Man's Vision

Guest Speaker is **Marianne Salas**, a botanical painter, photographer, and garden historian. Her love of Camellias prompted her to photograph and help catalog 1,000 existing Camellias at the former site of Gerbing Gardens on Amelia Island, which was a popular tourist destination in the 1930s and 40s.

Join us for an inside look into the history of Gerbing Gardens and its founder, local fisherman Gustav George Gerbing, who transformed seven acres of family property along the Amelia River into a public garden. Gerbing sold Camellias and ran a nursery on the property for over 14 years. Today the site is recognized for its historical significance, and is registered by the Archives of American Gardens at the Smithsonian Institute.
