

Native milkweeds are optimal choices for our landscapes but we all love the tropical varieties. Please remember to <u>cut back tropical</u> <u>milkweeds</u> during the month of November. This encourages our monarch butterflies to migrate and also protects caterpillars from ingesting the protozoan parasite *Ophryocystis elektroscirrha*.
