



The FFGC Matching Grants Program Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc. is pleased to offer matching grants up to \$500 to any Florida federated Garden Clubs and Circles in good standing. This fund was begun using the proceeds from a bank account no longer encumbered. The FFGC Finance Committee determined that the best use of these funds would be to offer our circles and clubs an opportunity to apply to use them on local projects.

The mission statement for FFGC states "The Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc promotes the love of gardening, floral and landscape design, and civic and environmental responsibility, by providing education, resources and networking opportunities for our members, youth and community." The focus and objectives outlined below form the basis for Club or Circle projects/activities that may qualify to receive matching funds. Projects/activities may be new or ongoing.

- a) Any activity (workshop, program or other educational event) aimed at **increasing membership** by welcoming interested individuals to your Club/Circle.
- b) An activity to **beautify your community**, such as park plantings, school gardens, a divided road median or roadside beautification.
- c) Any activity to **increase awareness** of our organization's mission, goals and objectives.

The Grant application is available online and may be downloaded from the www.ffgc.org website. Grant application deadline is **January 15 annually**. Funds will be awarded at our annual state convention. Grant funds must be expended by December 31 of the year awarded and a one-page report with pictures sent to the FFGC Matching Grants Chairman, Gina Jogan at gyiogan@panhandle.rr.com.

There will be a \$5,000 cap placed on grants awarded annually.






FFGC's Wekiva Youth Camp has been located at Wekiwa Springs State Park since 1974, under a partnership with the Florida Dept of Natural Resources and Division of Parks & Recreation. The facility has grown through the years and now boasts a swimming pool, craft hall, screened pavilion, dining hall, canteen, nature hut, outdoor amphitheater, sports field and Volunteer and Camper Cabins. Over a six-week period each summer, campers completing Grades 1-8 spend a week living in cabins clustered around a fire circle learning about the importance of conservation and protection of our environment in a protected natural setting. Adult Volunteers and Environmental Educators serve as Program Leaders and Role Models as our Campers enjoy swimming, hiking, nature photography, crafts, nature study, skit night, campfires, great food and more at this American Camp Association Accredited environmental youth camp. The Infirmary is staffed 24/7 with a Registered Nurse on site daily. Our Camp Director supervises the activities of the Campers and Counselors, many who are former campers themselves. Come see this wonderful camp and meet the Counselors, Director, and Staff.


#### What's New for 2023?

The mission of SEEK is to increase student environmental literacy through hands on and field based educational experiences. To inspire student interest and involvement in environmental conservation and protection; and to promote student development of environmental stewardship ethics as well as environmental career opportunities.

Some of the activities planned are field excursions and experiential activities at labs around the UF Campus. Students will visit a lab to understand the Florida aquifer and visit a spring location. A visit to the School of Forest Resources and Conservation to understand forest health and resilience as well as Florida's wetland ecosystems. The Honeybee Research Lab visit will review insects and impact of changing climates. Wrapping up the program will be a UF Panel to discuss Environmental Science Careers and offerings at UF.




