

Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc. is pleased to offer **matching grants up to \$500** to any Florida federated Garden Clubs and Circles in good standing. This fund was begun using the proceeds from a bank account no longer encumbered. The FFGC Finance Committee determined that the best use of these funds would be to offer our circles and clubs an opportunity to apply to use them on local projects.

The mission statement for FFGC states "The Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc promotes the love of gardening, floral and landscape design, and civic and environmental responsibility, by providing education, resources and networking opportunities for our members, youth and community." The focus and objectives outlined below form the basis for Club or Circle projects/activities that may qualify to receive matching funds. Projects/activities may be new or ongoing.

- a) Any activity (workshop, program or other educational event) aimed at increasing membership by welcoming interested individuals to your Club/Circle.
- b) An activity to **beautify your community**, such as park plantings, school gardens, a divided road median or roadside beautification.
 - c) Any activity to increase awareness of our organization's mission, goals and objectives.

The Grant application is available online and may be downloaded from the www.ffgc.org website.

Grant application deadline is January 15 annually. Funds will be awarded at our annual state convention. Grant funds must be expended by December 31 of the year awarded and a one-page report with pictures sent to the FFGC Finance Committee Chairman (FFGC 1st Vice President, President elect).

There will be a \$5,000 cap placed on grants awarded annually.



WEKIVA YOUTH CAMP VOLUNTEER TRAINING Friday, Feb. 11 (1 pm) – Sunday, Feb. 13 (10 am)

It is that time again for the 2022 Wekiva Volunteer Training. A weekend of friendship, nature and beauty of Wekiwa Springs State Park in Apopka.

FFGC's Wekiva Youth Camp has been located at Wekiwa Springs State Park since 1974. Over a six-week period each summer, campers completing grades 1-8 spend a week living in cabins and learning about the importance of conservation and protection of our environment.

Adult Volunteers and Environmental Educators serve as Program Leaders and Role Models to our Campers. Volunteers are housed in air-conditioned cabins with indoor plumbing. The infirmary is staffed with a Registered Nurse on site daily. Our Camp Director supervises the activities of the Campers and Counselors, many who are former campers.

Wekiva Volunteer Training is an excellent opportunity to become acquainted with summer volunteer opportunities. Space is limited. The first 30 registrants will have the opportunity for Volunteer cabins. After those spaces are filled, attendees will have the option of "living like a camper" in Camper Cabins with a bathhouse nearby. Bring a friend and learn about Wekiva Volunteer opportunities. 
What's New for 2022?

The mission of SEEK is to increase student environmental literacy through hands on and field based educational experiences. To inspire student interest and involvement in environmental conservation and protection; and to promote student development of environmental stewardship ethics as well as environmental career opportunities.

The field excursions and experiential activities focus on Exploring Florida's Hydrogeology. Students will visit a lab to understand the Florida aquifer and visit a spring location. A visit to the School of Forest Resources and Conservation to understand forest health and resilience as well as Florida's wetland ecosystems. The Honeybee Research Lab visit will review insects and impact of changing climates. There will be a trip to the Microbiology Lab to understand fungus and the importance in our environment. Wrapping up the program will be a UF Panel to discuss Environmental Science Careers and offerings at UF.






WAFA 2024 - Auckland, New Zealand


